

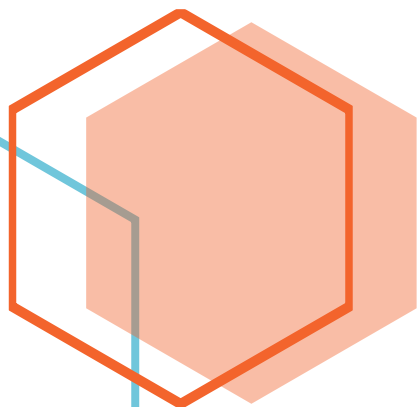


# 2025 AID Dermatoscopy Course
